**Procedure:**

- Make the sample Nomination Form and blank Nomination Forms available to the staff.
- Solicit nominations of suitable Grade 10 students from the staff.
- Convene a meeting of the Selection Committee, consisting of the Branch President (or designate), the Awards Representative (if your Branch has one), and at least one other teacher. The selection committee may also include student (s) if desired.
- From among the students for whom nomination forms were submitted to the committee, the committee will select ONE student to be the recipient of the Grade 10 Citizenship Award.

- Using the Sample Script provided, write a script about the student chosen for this award.
