OSSTF Motto: Let us not take thought for our separate interests, but let us help one another.

A. Selection:

A student shall be chosen in each regular secondary school from students presently completing Grade 10, by a school committee consisting of: the Branch President (or designate), the Branch Awards Committee Rep (if the Branch has one), and at least one other teacher. The committee may also have student rep(s) if desired.

B. Criteria:

1. The nominee is a Grade 10 student who contributes to the quality of life in the school unit (not necessarily a leader).
2. The nominee shows concern and consideration for others without regard for personal recognition.

C. Procedure:

- Make the sample Nomination Form and blank Nomination Forms available to the staff.
- Solicit nominations of suitable Grade 10 students from the staff.
- Convene a meeting of the Selection Committee. From among the students for whom nomination forms were submitted to the committee, the committee will select **ONE** student to be the recipient of the OSSTF Grade Ten Citizenship Award.
- Email (LaurieLafraniere@osstf11.com) with the name of your award recipient by **Friday, May 19, 2017**.
- An award package will be sent to your school to be presented at an appropriate award ceremony **at the school level**.
